

AIDA World Championships – Individual Outdoor 2019

Selection procedures AIDA Belgium

1. The AIDA Belgium Board of Directors (BD) is designated as the selection body for the AIDA World Championships Individual Outdoor 2019 (7-14 september 2019 – Nice, France). Decisions concerning the selection procedures are taken by a simple majority of the votes cast by the Board of Directors.
2. The members of the Board of Directors, potential candidates for selection, may not vote on the points concerning the selections.
3. In all cases, competitors must:
 - a. Have reached the age of 18 at the beginning of the AIDA World Championships
 - b. Have Belgian nationality,
 - c. Have a AIDA Belgium 2019 licence,
 - d. Apply by email to: contact@aidabelgium.be before **31 janvier 2019** and have not been under suspension for doping in the two years preceding the first day of the World Championships in any national or international federation.
4. The Board will propose a list of **2 female and 2 male athletes** who have responded to the AIDA Belgium selection procedures and ranked in descending order of performance between **01/06/2018 and the 31/05/2019**.
5. Selection procedures:
 - a. **Performance selected:**

The performance selected will be the best performance achieved for the CWT, FIM and CNF disciplines **between 01/06/2018 and 31/05/2019 during** an international AIDA ranking competition. The national records as of 01/12/2018 are the reference for the establishment of minima presented. Athletes with these national records, who have applied on time, have a priority for this selection.
 - b. **The selection is subject to:**
 - i. The minimum participation **between 01/06/2018 until the 31/05/2019 during** in an international AIDA ranking depth competition by discipline where the candidate applies.
 - ii. the achievement of the minimum requirements in at least 2 disciplines:

6. If a tie remains for the last qualifying place with minimums, the Board will decide between the candidates according to sporting criteria (other performances achieved, regularity of athletes, etc...).
7. Any athlete selected on the AIDA Belgium list of selected athletes shall undertake to comply with a set of rules with regard to AIDA Belgium and its partners, any organiser and competitor.
8. Only AIDA Belgium can decide who officially belongs to the AIDA Belgium selection and can claim the title of "member of the Belgian AIDA team" in order to use it on its own behalf.
9. Any particular case concerning an athlete who has applied and who may occur during the selection period shall be discussed within the Board, in order to determine whether or not to propose to the selection this athlete, even if he does not meet all the conditions required by this text, a selection to the national team cannot be summarised as mathematics.
10. AIDA Belgium undertakes to support the selected athletes by providing clothing (t-shirts, sweaters, jackets) and financial sponsorship up to 200 euros per athlete. All the athlete's personal sponsors remain at his charge and have his own person.
